TRANSITION TO SECONDARY SCHOOL

Students move successfully into Year 7 classes at our school through

- * a planned transition program
- * communication between parents and the schools (KCS and RPS)
- * provision of bus service to and from school

Families will receive a School Information pack before transition visits. This will include:

- * Letter outlining transition process
- * Data sheet with student details
- * Parent information booklet
- * Curriculum information
- * Bus route information
- * Sample of transition timetable
- * Various pamphlets

The pack will be distributed via students at their primary school or by post.

The Year 6-7 Transition Committee is comprised of representatives from both Kingston Community School and Robe Primary School. This group meets once per term to discuss the transition program in that year.

The transition to high school program involves:

- RPS and KCS joint class activities in Terms 1 and 2
- Communication from primary schools on the online registration process
- A formal transition information evening at KCS in Term 2 including school tours
- Staff support with the digital enrolment process and platform
- Subject taster days where students complete high school timetabled subjects with specialist teachers on Monday or Tuesday Week 8, Term 4
- An overnight team building transition camp to Tarooki, Robe, Term 4

Extended transition programs and extra school tours can be arranged through the school if required.

School uniform is required for transition visits. A hat is needed for outside activities during transition visits. Students should also bring their pencil cases and school bags.

Booklists and consent forms will be sent to the students, who have indicated in the online registration process that they are enrolling at our school, at the end of the year via our standard enrolment procedures.
